GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

****All trailers will be parked in designated areas****

1. **The Van Zandt County Fair is open to Texas cattle only (*please note this is different and changes our status with Texas Animal Health Commission,- health papers no longer required*). Our Junior Livestock Show is open to only Junior Exhibitors from Van Zandt County. The Open Show is open to both junior and adult exhibitors.**
 2. All entry applications must be in or postmarked by Saturday April 10 2010.
 3. Judge's decision will be final!
 4. The management will not be responsible for any loss of, damage to, exhibits that may occur.
 5. Each exhibitor will be expected to care for their animals and keep exhibit area clean and presentable at all times.
 6. All rules and regulations of the show shall be subject to amendment, change or interpretation by Executive committee.
 7. The Superintendent of the show will have full and complete charge of all exhibits in their show, and all questions arising in that show will be decided by him/her. Their decision will be final.
 8. All registration papers will be checked on arrival. Photo copies may be used. Animals without registration papers will be shown in the ALL OTHER BREEDS classes.
- NOTE: if you require special stalling due to your exhibit, please make note on your entry form. We will try to accommodate you.**

JUNIOR SHOW RULES

Show starts at 9:00 a.m. Show Order: Showmanship, Heifer Show and Groups of 5

RULES

1. Show is open to all bonafide 4-H and FFA members.
2. Five (5) head makes a breed. All others will show under All Other Breeds Classes
3. There will be Junior, Intermediate and Senior Showmanship, prior to the start of the Junior show. Juniors are considered 9-11, Intermediate 12-14, and seniors are considered 15 and up. Age is as of show day.
4. There will be a BEST GROUP OF 5 Contest at the conclusion of the junior show. Only 5 head from the same 4-H or FFA chapter can compete as a group. A special trophy will be awarded to the winning group. Cattle will be displayed in a similar fashion as a Get-of-Sire or Produce-of-Dam contests. **BEST GROUP OF 5 COMPETITION IS ONLY FOR VAN ZANDT COUNTY 4-H CLUBS AND FFA CHAPTERS**
5. Buckles will be awarded to breed champions
6. Judge is TBA. Judge's decision is final.

1. September 2009 and younger
2. August-May 2009
3. April-January 2009
4. December-September 2008
5. August-May 2008

6. April January 2008

7. December 2007 and older.

- All entries must be received or postmarked by Saturday, April 10, 2010
- No entries will be considered unless official entry application is received
- Entry fee of \$20.00 per head must accompany entry blanks. Late entries will be \$30 per head. No refunds.

- Premiums: Only ribbons and special awards to champions and reserve champions will be given.
